Visitors to Lenape Park will have noticed Perkasie's new amphitheater taking shape. This exciting new development allows for a brand new venue for our Summer Concert Series, expanded Parks and Recreation programming and is expected to become an important and entertaining community resource.



In 2017, Perkasie Borough won the Oldcastle Precast "Building a New Tomorrow" Program, which is intended to provide resources to the communities in which Oldcastle's employees live and work. The award gifted a precast structure to Perkasie Borough for use as an outdoor amphitheater.

JONNECTION

The Borough's engineers and staff have since been working with Oldcastle designers on plans, budgets and site challenges for the amphitheater. Originally the structure was to sit on the north side of the Perkiomen Creek but concerns about the extent of the flood plain meant that its location was moved to its current spot on the south side of the creek, close to the park's volleyball court and skate park pavilion on Constitution Avenue.

Additional funding for the engineering, excavation, footers and improvements to the surrounding area was provided by a Bucks County Open Space grant. These additional improvements include the Quad Restrooms located by skate park pavilion which are open for public use.

Perkasie Borough presents "The Nerds" and a Grand Opening Event at the amphitheater on the evening of Wednesday June 15th as we kick off our free, outdoor Summer Concert Series.

2022 Collection and Disposal of Refuse Reminders

3

Residents are reminded of the Rules & Regulations for trash collection. Borough crews will leave an enforcement sticker on refuse that does not comply with the Borough's Ordinance.

- BOROUGH Bags: Trash in BOROUGH bags is collected curbside
 - Maximum bag weight is 40lbs (large) or 20lbs (small)
 - Bags must be securely fastened or tied
 - We do not collect trash set out in generic/regular trash bags
- Toters/Trash cans: Trash in BOROUGH toters is collected curbside
 - Toter lid must be fully closed
 - Additional trash may be placed in a BOROUGH bag next to the closed toter. We do not collect additional trash in generic/regular trash bags.

• **BOROUGH trash bags** may be purchased at Borough Hall, at Giant, Landis or the Olde Towne Convenience Store.

1) **Plant native plants!** Native plants provide biodiversity and require less maintenance and water to thrive.


2) **Mulch your grass clippings.** Grass clippings are a source of nitrogen fertilizer. Let them decompose on your lawn and never blow them into the street.

When should I call 911?

You should call 911 whenever you are worried about your own or someone else's safety, or if you are a witness to a crime and for fires or medical emergencies – Do not hesitate to call– it is never a bother – we are here to serve.

Our non-emergency police number is 215-257-6876. Our police offices are staffed Monday through Friday with administrative staff from 8:30 am to 4:30 am excluding official holidays. After hours and weekends the non-emergency number is answered by the Bucks County Police, Fire and EMS Dispatch Center

What should I expect when I call 911?

- Provide the dispatcher with the following details (try to remain calm and speak in a clear voice):
- Location of emergency as exact as possible (address, names of town, roads, crossstreets, intersections, landmarks)
- Nature of the emergency (inform dispatcher of injuries/dangerous situations (threats to persons and/or property)
- Provide your Name and your Phone Number
- Provide further information as needed and answer questions
- Stay on the line DON'T HANG UP UNTIL ALL INFORMATION IS COMMUNICATED OR UNTIL INSTRUCTED BY DISPATCHER
- Emergency landline calls to 911 made from your home will provide emergency dispatchers with the caller's exact address.
- Emergency calls to 911 made from your cell phone will not provide an exact location and will vary depending on the type of wireless phone used and the number and location of cell phone towers in the area.
- Never assume your location can be traced (Don't Go Where You Don't Know) and be prepared to provide location information (address, name of town, roads, cross-streets, intersections and landmarks).

The Perkasie Borough Police Department is staffed twenty four hours a day by eighteen full-time police officers. Police headquarters is located at 311 S. 9th Street in Perkasie Borough. The Police Department also provides full-time contracted police services to Sellersville Borough.

The Perkasie Police Department provides a wide array of professional police services including services such as child safety seat installation. To schedule a child safety seat install or inspection please call our non-emergency number 215-257-6876.

If you have medications like you would like to dispose of safely and securely there is a prescription medication drop collection box located in the police department lobby which can be accessed Monday through Friday from 8:30 am to 4:30 pm.

Reminders from the Code Enforcement Department



Know what's below. Call before you dig.

Doing home renovations? You probably need a permit!

Doing some home renovations? Before you get started, make sure you check with the Perkasie Borough Code Enforcement/Permits Department to see if you need a permit to do the work.

Obtaining a permit gives you legal permission to start construction and has these other positive benefits.

It ensures that contractors do good work. Profit-driven contractors might be tempted to cut corners, but a building permit ensures that they use safe construction methods and materials. And, an inspection ensures you that the contractor did the work correctly. It also protects your home's value. Permits are public record, and potential home buyers can see whether improvements to the home were completed with the proper permits.

To obtain a permit you must submit the appropriate permit application that pertains to your project. All applications must be submitted to Perkasie Borough and must be accompanied with Site and/or Building plans. If your project is extensive, you will likely need to hire an architect or other professional to draw the project as it will be constructed (to show that it will meet building and zoning codes). ALL commercial projects must have signed and sealed plans submitted with the application.

Projects that need Construction and/or Zoning Permits:

- Change the use of a room (such as by converting a garage to a living room)
- Fences over 6' in height
- Roofing, re-roofing, or roof replacement
- Mechanical / HVAC systems
- Electrical systems, changing or adding any electrical wiring
- Plumbing systems, changing or adding plumbing
- Decks
- Storage buildings and Prefabricated structures 120 sqft and greater
- New homes or structures
- Additions
- Garage enclosures, Carports
- Renovations
- Add or remove walls or egresses (windows, doors etc.)
- Temporary Buildings
- Demolitions
- Driveways / sidewalks
- Swimming Pools / hot tubs
- All Commercial property repair / renovations

Projects that don't usually need a permit include:

- Exterior Painting
- Interior painting, wall papering or similar finish work
- Adding Cabinets and Counter Tops
- Replacing certain kitchen appliances
- Repaving a driveway
- Installing floor coverings, or
- Swings and small scale playground equipment
- Fences 7' or less in height
- Residential storage buildings under 120 sqft (Zoning permit is still required)
- Residing, Replacing existing Doors or Windows

An Update on the South Perkasie Covered Bridge

As many of our residents know, the South Perkasie Covered Bridge in Lenape Park sustained major damage last year from the remnants of Hurricane Ida. Perkasie

Borough has been working with local, state and federal groups on a plan to rehab the bridge and prevent future damage to it.

Here is a status update on that project.

- After the covered bridge moved 15 feet off its abutments during Ida, Perkasie Borough Council approved the use of emergency funds to stabilize the bridge. Local contractors and a national covered bridge expert supervised that project.
- 2. Perkasie Borough's engineer put out a request for bids for a design and plan to rehab the timber bridge with the addition of new abutments. The Borough has received bids from qualified applicants for the timber. The plan requires including taking measures to raise the bridge and secure it to its abutments. Then a second bid will be necessary for the abutment work.
- Perkasie Borough in conjunction with Bucks County submitted the bridge on its storm damage report to FEMA. Borough and state officials met with FEMA on January 24 to start the approval process of getting additional FEMA funds to fix the bridge and build new

abutments. Those meetings are on-going as we await a final decision on funding.

- 4. Perkasie Borough along with the Perkasie Historical Society, the Bucks County Covered Bridge Society and other partners had raised \$217,000 for the project before the flood. Our hope is that the FEMA funds will pay for additional project costs.
- 5. Until Perkasie receives funding approval from FEMA, the Borough will continue to take measures to safeguard the bridge and work with state and local officials on the project.

Since September 2021, Perkasie Borough staff and elected officials have spent many hours on this very complicated project, which has included working with different levels of county, state, and federal government. We remain optimistic that our covered bridge will be back on its feet as an important part of our park system.

The Perkasie Borough Revitalization & Its Economic Impacts

Perkasie Borough grows 185 new jobs from new and existing businesses in 2021. This is an increase of 13% in the job growth rate over 2020. Total employment rose in Perkasie from 1,429 in 2020 to 1,614 in 2021.

New home sales in Perkasie are showing elevated pricing values in today's real estate market. Townhomes at both Cedar Ridge and The Fields at Constitution Square began listings at \$335,000 to \$350,000 and have currently been selling between \$400,000 to \$450,000.

Even amidst a Pandemic, new and upcoming businesses are opening in Perkasie. These new businesses include "It's Grooming Time" on Walnut Street and "CLX Publishing" and "Hickory Stick Ice Cream" both on 7th Street.

Hickory Stick Ice Cream - "Serving Our Community, One Scoop at a Time"

"We are moving the Hickory Stick Ice Cream #2, our Buckingham store location, to our hometown of Perkasie," explained owner Laura Devlin enthusiastically. "We cannot wait to add even more ideas and items to the menu as we grow in our new location."

When owners Laura & Tom Devlin took over Hickory Stick Ice Cream in 2019 in Silverdale, never in their wildest dreams did they think Hickory Stick could be as it is today, especially with a pandemic in the mix. They are keeping their first location in Silverdale with Perkasie being their second location now. "As Perkasie residents we want to be part of the exciting growth going on in the Town Center," remarked Devlin. "We purchased our home in Perkasie in April 2015. Our children attend Pennridge School District



where you can find me volunteering at our local elementary schools along with North Middle School! Hickory Stick hosts over 50 fundraisers each year for community organizations and NOW get to do it at BOTH locations!"

Hickory Stick's new location in Perkasie (the former Rita's) at 7 N. Seventh Street, in the American House Building, will feature over 16 Premium Ice Cream, artisan crafted flavors using the highest quality and freshest ingredients. In addition, Hickory Stick will serve Italian Ice, Premium Soft Serve, Ice Cream Pies, Gertrude Hawk Chocolate, Rocco Dog Treats and Sweet Victory for allergy customers. There will be a wide array of beverages and best of course, they will feature the world's famous "Stock's Pound Cake Bars." And, if that weren't enough they will also have the best butter cake in town, straight from Philadelphia!

The Delbar - Historic apartments in the heart of Perkasie.

The Delbar is a transformative Perkasie development project by local builder and developer Ed Moser from The Moser Group that will be open for occupancy in Summer 2022. The Delbar project along 7th and Spruce Streets has repurposed a vacant factory building into a stunning residential complex with 98 units featuring industrial windows, exposed brick walls and restored oak timbers.

In Perkasie he has created an imaginative living space in the Delbar Project by accentuating the hidden aesthetics lying dormant within the existing buildings.

Perkasie Train Station - Repurposed into New Town Center Restaurant

The community will see the renovation of the Perkasie Train



Station into a new Town Center restaurant. Joe Wade, owner of the Rams Pint House, holds the lease for the building from SEPTA and will be restoring the old station and adding an event space. A new liquor license was recently approved by Borough Council for the Station.

"My family has lived in Perkasie for 20 years, we love this town,"

commented Joe Wade. "We noticed over our time here a need for restaurants downtown. As the town grew we saw this demand and created the Rams Pint House."

"Our concept for the Train Station, at this moment, is to create a wedding and event space that focuses on catering," explained Wade. "The hall will hold weddings, events, rehearsal dinners, movie nights and improve upon our very popular outside beer garden. We want to keep the building as authentic as possible and add outside fire pits on the patio. We're designing a quaint space with a deck overlooking Town Center at the "Top of Chestnut" where people can enjoy the tree lighting and events."

The restaurant portion of the station will have a Tex/Mex themed cuisine, with smoked bbq and a mix of the best of Latin/ Mexican foods. There will be a bottle shop with speciality wines and beer sales and a self-serve beer tap wall. (This would be the only one in the area.) The catering hall section will have a full service custom menu specific to each event for parties up to 150.

The Rams Pint House actively supports our local community such as Ram Packs, Pennridge Little League, Green Jackets and the Police & Fire Departments.






