IMPROVEMENTS COMING TO RESIDENTIAL CURBSIDE RECYCLING

We are increasing the frequency of curbside recycling collection, making it even easier for residents to recycle.

Starting on July 10th 2023, residents should set out paper & cardboard for collection EVERY FRIDAY and their plastics, glass, tin & aluminum ("comingled") EVERY WEEK on the SAME DAY as TRASH. As always, residents are also able to drop off separated recyclables at the Borough's Recycling Drop Off Center. Residents should not put plastic bags in the recycling bin or place recyclables in plastic bags. We will no longer collect plastic bags, nor accept them at the Recycling Center.

Perkasie Borough is one of only 2 municipalities in Bucks County that provide trash & recycling services directly to their residents, and the only municipality in the County that operates dualstream recycling. Dual-stream recycling means that our residents separate paper & cardboard from other comingled recyclables. The practice means that the recycling stream is "cleaner", more materials are recycled, and we can keep recycling costs lower for our residents.


Perkasie Borough recently used grant funding from the Department of Environmental Protection to purchase a baling machine which is housed at the residential Recycling Drop Off Center. Baling paper & cardboard has significantly reduced the costs of recycling these materials and even positions the Borough to generate income from the sale of paper & cardboard as and when the commodity price increases. Revenues will be used to offset the increasing costs of disposing of comingled recyclables.

"Increasing the frequency of curbside collection and moving comingled to the regular trash day will make it a lot easier and less confusing for our residents to recycle" said Steve Rose, Borough Councilman and Chair of the Public Works Committee. "It also means that we'll increase recycling rates for the community as a whole and increase the amount of paper & cardboard that we bale and recycle".


It is important that residents take note of the changes. After July 10th, we can only collect materials set out correctly, and following the new schedule. We will not collect paper & cardboard

if it is mixed with other recyclables, and we can't recycle any materials that are mixed in with trash or food waste.

We have updated the trash and recycling pages at perkasieborough.org to reflect the changes and residents should have received a color postcard in the mail. Anyone with questions about the new schedule should call the Borough office at (215)-257-5065.

Perkasie Borough is a mandated community under Act 101, which means that residents and all commercial, institutional, educational and religious institutions are required to recycle under the law. Questions about Perkasie Borough's Recycling Program should be directed to the Public Works Director at (215)-257-5065.

LETTER FROM THE MAYOR

For this newsletter I would like to highlight the incredible work that has gone into the efforts to restore the South Perkasie Covered Bridge with minimal financial impact on our budget. I want to congratulate Scott Bomboy, Andrea Coaxum, and others in our Borough Administration who demonstrated remarkable patience and persistence in acquiring this dedicated funding. Please see updates regarding the restoration of the South Perkasie Covered Bridge below, written by Scott Bomboy.

In late April, FEMA awarded two major grants to Perkasie Borough to repair our historic 1832 covered bridge. Perkasie is eligible for FEMA funds to return the bridge to its condition before Hurricane Ida since the bridge is on the National Register of Historic Places.

The FEMA grant awards are for a minimum of \$427,000. Before Ida, the Perkasie Historical Society had raised \$120,000 to rehab the bridge, and Perkasie Borough was awarded a \$100,000 state grant in June 2020 based on the society's match.

In all, the Covered Bridge repair project now has a minimum of \$689,000 in dedicated funding, including a FEMA emergency grant in 2021 to stabilize the bridge.

The funding was the outcome of 15 months' of discussions between Borough representatives, FEMA, and the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. To our knowledge, FEMA has only funded four other covered bridge projects in recent years nationally.

Perkasie Borough had fully documented the bridge for its state grant, which gave FEMA the critical data needed for its grant awards. The Borough will advertise for planning proposals for the project shortly. Once we award those bids, we will have an estimated completion date for the project.

We all look forward to the day when the covered bridge returns to active use in Lenape Park. I'll have more updates in the coming months on this important project!

Perkasie Borough Honored With National Award For Outstanding Safety Practices

WASHINGTON, D.C., May 2, 2023 – Perkasie Borough has earned the American Public Power Association's Safety Award of Excellence for safe operating practices in 2022. The utility earned First Place award in Group A in the category for utilities with 12,480 worker-hours of annual worker exposure.

"Safety needs to be the first thing on every utility employee's mind as they go about their work," said Jim Boyd, Chair of APPA's Safety Committee and Electric Operations Safety Manager at Tacoma Power, Tacoma Washington. "The utilities honored by APPA for excellence in this area should be proud of the culture they have instilled in serving their communities."

283 utilities from across the country entered the annual Safety Awards. Entrants were placed in categories according to their number of worker-hours and ranked based on incident-free records and overall state of their safety programs and culture during 2022. The incidence rate is based on the number of work-related reportable injuries or illnesses and the number

of worker-hours during 2022, as defined by the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA).

"Perkasie Borough cares deeply about sending our employees home to their families safely every single day," said Andrea Coaxum, Perkasie Borough manager. "We are proud to be honored for all the work that goes into standing behind this commitment."

The Safety Awards have been held annually for more than 65 years. APPA is the voice of not-for-profit, community-owned utilities that power 2,000 towns and cities nationwide.

SUMMER STORMWATER MANAGEMENT

Stormwater runoff is a major pollutant of our local waterways. It flows from rooftops, over paved streets, sidewalks, parking lots, across bare soil and lawns. As it flows, runoff collects and transports many different kinds of pollutants. This water drains directly into nearby creeks and streams without being treated at a sewage plant.

Luckily, there are many steps that you can take to help reduce the amount of pollutants entering our waterways.

Here are some tips to manage stormwater pollution this summer:



- Pick up after your dog. Their waste is not natural, its full of bacteria and excess nutrients that will create algae blooms and contaminate local waterways.
- Water your lawn & garden slowly. Only water your grass and plants when necessary. When watering, be sure to do so slowly to reduce runoff. Consider investing in irrigation hoses or gator bags where possible.
- Wash your car the right way. Either wash it at a car wash that filters wastewater, or in a grassy area.

The Perkasie Borough Police Department is implementing several new programs to assist our residents.

The first program is a **Blue Envelope Program**, which is modeled after a program that was first developed and distributed in the State of Connecticut. The program has also been adopted by police agencies in several other states including New Jersey.

The purpose of the Blue Envelope is to improve the interaction between a driver with autism spectrum disorder (ASD) and Police Officers on a traffic stop. The Blue Envelope provides written information and guidance on enhancing effective communication between police officers and persons with ASD.

The primary goal of the Blue Envelope Program is to assist drivers with ASD with document organization and to help them understand what to do on a motor vehicle stop. The envelope's instructions warn the driver that the officer might have a radio and flashing lights on their patrol car. The instructions also direct the driver to keep his or her hands on the steering wheel until they receive further instructions from the officer. The directions detail the process of events that should occur during the stop and how the driver should respond.

The Blue Envelope also provides Police Officers with the means to quickly identify an operator of a motor vehicle who has ASD and helps to guide Police Officers with the interaction.

The Police Officer's section of the envelope explains some behaviors that the driver might exhibit, including repetitive body movements and signs of high anxiety. Police Officers are also instructed to allow the driver extra time to respond, to use the most simplistic language possible and to clearly tell the driver when he or she can leave the scene.

The ASD driver can place a copy of their driver's license, registration and insurance cards inside the envelope for quick access. The envelope also contains an emergency contact form for the ASD driver.

The Blue Envelopes are available for pick up at the Perkasie Borough Police Department located at 311 S. 9th Street, Perkasie.

The second program is a **Handle with Care Registry**. Law enforcement and other first responders frequently have contact with residents who have communication, cognitive and physical needs that make providing services to them more difficult.

Emergency situations often create high anxiety, excitement and physical demands thus exacerbating these pre-existing conditions. In an effort to preemptively address these needs, the Perkasie Borough Police Department has embarked on an initiative to better assist our residents with special needs called, 'Handle with Care'. 'Handle with Care' residents can include, but are not limited to, elderly, dementia, Alzheimer's, autistic, or any other cognitive or physical condition which may require specific attention or assistance in an emergency.

Handle with Care Information can be accessed through the department Crime Watch web page https://bucks.crimewatchpa. com/perkasieboroughpd

The data will be used to provide officers with information they need to help a "Handle with Care" resident who is without their caregiver, who may have wandered from home or who otherwise is in need of assistance. This form will provide the officers with vital information to ensure the 'Handle with Care' resident is properly cared for in an emergency situation. All information in the registry will be held in strict confidence.

Last but not least the Perkasie Borough Police Department has partnered with the Bucks County Human Services Division to participate in an **Upper Bucks Co-Responder Program**.

The Human Services Division in Bucks County (the "County") oversees funding and contractual services for individuals in need of social services throughout the County. The following entities fall within the Human Services Division: the Area Agency on Aging, Behavioral Health and Developmental Programs, Children and Youth Social Services Agency, and the Bucks County Drug and Alcohol Commission. The mission of the Division is to support and strengthen individual and family wellness through community connections, collaboration, integration, and responsible stewardship of resources. The overarching goals of the Initiative are to: (i) decrease the time law enforcement spends responding to situations involving social service's needs, (ii) provide a more effective emergency response through the addition of clinical-informed support and an enhanced community resource knowledge base, and(iii) divert individuals primarily presenting with social services needs from further penetration into the criminal justice system.





Perry Mill Development

Work is well underway on the Perry Mill development at the corner of 8th & Market. HG Properties are constructing 28 new rowhomes in two, 14-unit buildings with a detached garage shared between every two units and accessed via an alley to the rear. Each home also has a 2nd off street parking space. Sidewalks will be installed along the length of N. 8th St along with a paved trail connecting Arch St to N. 8th St. Plans for the development have been subject to rigorous review by the Perkasie Planning Commission, the Bucks County Planning Commission and Perkasie Borough Council as part of the municipal Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance (SALDO).

The development lies within the Borough's Row Home Infill Overlay district, created in 2021. The overlay provides an additional option for development on underused parcels which preserves



the historic neighborhood fabric and reflects the architecture of the older parts of the Borough. Rowhomes as a residential dwelling unit in Perkasie are steeped in historical roots. Most of these rowhomes were built in the early 1900's as homes for workers in local businesses. The earliest rowhomes in Perkasie are across from the old train station on Eighth Street between Market and Chestnut Streets.

Stipulations in the new Overlay, which make rowhomes distinct from townhome developments, include:

- building materials must be similar to materials of the surrounding neighborhood or use scale, form, architectural detailing, etc., to establish compatibility.
- brick and/or stone must be used to clad the entire front façade, and vinyl/aluminum siding, metal, concrete and/or stucco are not permitted.
- roofs have to be similar to surrounding neighborhoods and should include dormers, gables, pitch, parapets or cornices
- homes must have front porches at least 6' deep, spanning the entire length of the front facade of the building, and elevated at least 3' above the street

The Perry Mill development is being built on land first used in the 1880's, when J.G. Moyer, the owner of a coal and lumber business at the corner of 7th & Market extended operations into this area. Local farmers would bring wagons of hay to be compressed & baled, after Mr Moyer added a hay press in 1889. In 1944, Shelly and Fenstermacher of Souderton purchased the land for use as a building and fuel business. Storage bins were renovated and new buildings constructed in the mid-1970s. The lumber yard closed in 2017 and the land has stood vacant since then.

Perry Mill provides new housing, within walking distance of Perkasie's thriving business & retail area, and in keeping with the architectural style of the surrounding, historic neighborhoods.

Dairy Queen

You may have noticed that Perkasie's DQ has recently undergone significant renovations and an impressive facelift! DQ was one of the properties significantly affected in the devastating flooding caused by the aftermath of Hurricane Ida in 2021. The rushing waters broke a window and flooded the DQ building, causing almost \$100K in damage to the structure and its contents. As he considered repair and renovations, DQ owner Steve Vernaccio made sure that his plans built in a number of flood mitigation measures. Under the supervision of Steve's son Anthony Vernaccio and long-time manager, Mary Roatche, serving windows were replaced with double paned glass and raised by 48" to be above the level of flood waters, and a sump pump was installed in case water needs to be pumped out. Remote cameras & wifi were added to allow for remote observation during future flooding events. The facelift also included an new iconic red roof, new stucco and siding, air curtains in front of the serving windows and improvements to the lot and seating areas. The cost of the renovations was approximately \$225K, a huge investment in Perkasie for a small local business.

President Brent Alles explained that they are about to expand into the residential market with a new offering of closet systems for mud rooms, kitchens and dressing rooms. The Closet Shop




