## PERKASIE SKATE PARK RULES & REGULATIONS

There is an inherent risk associated with Perkasie skate park activities. Serious injury or death may result from falling, colliding with other users, or being hit by a board. Users of skate parks, by their participation, accept these inherent risks. Skate park users have a duty to exercise good judgment, use personal protective equipment, and act in a responsible manner.

Respect other riders. Share the space.

The use of personal protective equipment is strongly recommended. Such equipment includes: helmets, knee pads, elbow pads and wrist guards. Shirts and shoes shall be worn at all times.

Know your abilities and skate with in them. Skulls and concrete don't mix!

The following items are not permitted in the Perkasie skate park area:

- Alcoholic beverages, drugs or tobacco products
- Profanity, abusive language, spitting, pushing, fighting, reckless, or other inappropriate behavior
- Littering and glass containers
- Spectators, non-skaters or pets
- Loud music, radios or boom boxes
- Weapons

- Chewing gum, food and/or drinks.
- Spectators should watch from outside fenced area.

Graffiti or vandalism will result in IMMEDIATE closure of the Perkasie skate park and in criminal prosecution.

Do not use the Perkasie skate park while under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

Skating, biking and/or scooter riding is not permitted on areas surrounding the skate park such as curbs, ramps, benches, picnic tables, play apparatus, pavilions, etc.

- Do not use the Perkasie skate park when surfaces are wet, snow covered or icy.
- No trespassing when park is closed violators will be prosecuted.
- The Perkasie skate park is open from dawn to 8 pm (winter) & sunrise to 9 pm (summer).
- All organized events, contests, camps and special events require prior written approval from the Borough of Perkasie.
- Failure to obey rules may result in suspension of park privileges.
- Failure to follow the above rules and regulations may result in a citation or fine up to \$1,000.
