PUBLIC HEARING ON ORDINANCE #1019, ZONING ORDINANCE & MAP AMENDMENT TO RE-ZONE TAX PARCELS 33-005-438 AND 33-005-456 FROM INDUSTRIAL 2 (I-2) TO RESIDENTIAL 3 (R-3)

A public hearing was held to receive comments on an amendment to the zoning ordinance to rezone or change the zoning of Bucks County tax parcels nos. 33-005-438 and 33-005-456 from industrial-2 to residential-3 (R-3). HISTORICAL COMMITTEE

Present was a representative from the Covered Bridge Association who presented the Borough with a book on covered bridges.

PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE

Skate Park Ramp Resurfacing

Upon motion by Purcell, seconded by Clark, Council unanimously approved the replacement of the skate park riding surface for a total cost of \$11,061.68.

Considering Extending Contract Solid Waste Disposal

Upon motion by Rose, seconded by Faulkner, Council unanimously accepted the one year contract extension with Waste Management for Municipal Solid Waste Disposal for the year 2020 at a cost of \$79.00 per ton.

PUBLIC UTILITY COMMITTEE

Consider Ordinance #1020, Electric Standard and Service

Upon motion by Purcell, seconded by Ryder, Council unanimously approved Ordinance #1020, an ordinance of the Borough amending Chapter 85 of the Perkasie Borough Code pertaining to electrical standards and service.

PLANNING AND ZONING COMMITTEE

Consider Resolution #2019-26, Lot Line Adjustment-Pennridge Airport

Upon motion by Purcell, seconded by Rose, Council unanimously approved Resolution #2019-26, a resolution of the Borough of Perkasie approving the lot line adjustment submitted by Pennridge Development Enterprises, Inc. as a final plan approval.

Consider Ordinance #1019, Zoning Ordinance & Map Amendment to Rezone Tax Parcels 33-005-438 and 33-005-456 from Industrial-2 (I-2) to Residential-3 (R-3)

Upon motion by Rose seconded Purcell, Council considered a motion to approve ordinance #1019 of the Borough amending Chapter 186 of the Zoning Ordinance to rezone tax parcels #33-005-438, 33-005, 33-05-005-456 from Industrial-2 (I-2) to Residential-3 (R-3). All Councilmembers voted in favor of the motion with the exception of Aaron Clark who voted against. Motion carried 6-1. Ordinance 1019 was approved.

PARK AND RECREATION COMMITTEE

Upon motion by Faulkner, seconded by Clark, Council unanimously approved an event permit application for the Pennridge High School Parade scheduled for October 18, 209 beginning at 5:30PM at Guth Elementary and ending at Pennridge High School.

PERSONNEL AND POLICY COMMITTEE

Consider Advertising Draft Ordinance #1022-Police Pension Plan

Upon motion by Ryder, seconded by Clark, Council unanimously agreed to advertise Ordinance #1022, an ordinance of Perkasie Borough electing to amend its police pension plan administered by the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement System pursuant to Article IV of the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement Law; Agreeing to be bound by provisions of the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement Law as amended and as applicable to members municipalities.

FINANCE COMMITTEE

Authorization to Pay Bills

Upon a motion by Clark, seconded by Rose, Council unanimously accepted payment of the bills as presented.

Consider Financial Donation to Bucks County Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals

Council agreed to include a donation to the Bucks County Society for the prevention to cruelty to animals in next year's budget.

Resolution #2019-25, Escrow Release #4-Pennridge Business Park

Upon motion by Faulkner, seconded by Purcell, Council unanimously approved Resolution #2019-25 to authorize a reduction in the escrow for the Pennridge Airport Business Park Lot #2 as approved by Gilmore and Associates, Inc., in the amount of \$280,758.83 to reduce the total escrow to \$665,796.52 and to authorize the signature of the Borough Manager on the escrow reduction.

Consider Letter of Intent and Commission Agreement-3rd Floor Tenant

Upon motion by Purcell, seconded by Ryder, Council unanimously approved the Commission agreement and letter of intent dated August 7, 2019, with marks ups, noting that final terms and lease conditions to be determined in the lease agreement document to be approved by Borough Council at a future meeting.

Consider Closing PLGIT Account for DWK Industries-Borough3rd Floor Tenant

Upon motion by Faulkner, seconded by Clark, Council unanimously approved to close the PLGIT account for DWK Industries and return the remaining security deposit.
