2. Public Forum - none
3. Approval of Meeting Minutes: February 17th, motioned by Chris, seconded by Kathy, all in favor.
4. Old Business Updates
 - Dog Park Maintenance - Parks and Recreation is looking into ways of helping the park drain so it's not consistently muddy. Although it has been noted we have had one of the wettest years on record.
 - LBT Feasibility Study will be shared once it is completed. All the research is going into one final report which should be available shortly.
 - Great American Clean Up – a handful of volunteer groups in the area (including scouts and Pennridge South) helped clean up Menlo and trails in Perkasie. Our official event has not been rescheduled just yet
 - National Trails Day – unfortunately no one from the Park and Recreation Board is available for the Farmer's Market. We will have trail maps of Perkasie/Sellersville to hand out

 - Summer Programming – suggestion for a running program, will need to find an instructor and confirm a class
 - Spruce Street Swings – will be looking into placement and install dates with Public Works
 - Summer Concert Series – send information out to residents, only in the Menlo Guide at the moment

 - Subject of Middle School Baseball was discussed with first contacting the Athletic Directors about a possible program within the district for the community. This is not a park and recreation program, it would be through the schools.
 - A meeting at Menlo should take place in July or August, so the members can see the pool if they don't go on a consistent basis. It must be advertised due to the location change if we decide to meet there.
