Changes To Perkasie Borough's Bulky Waste Collection Service Set For Spring 2025

Perkasie Borough is implementing changes to its bulky waste collection program as part of a broader effort to manage waste costs, streamline collection processes, clarify service provision for residents, and to bring the Borough's pricing and service levels into line with today's standards. Following an observation study of customer behavior and an analysis of current industry practices, Borough staff have recommended updates to both the frequency of collection and the types of items that qualify as bulky waste. These changes are expected to take effect in spring 2025, following the implementation of a public education campaign.

Under the updated guidelines, bulky waste collection will occur once per month during the first full week instead of weekly, meaning that residential customers will be allowed one bulky waste item per month at no additional charge. Bulky waste items are things that are too large to fit inside a Borough disposal bag or a Borough wheeled trash cart.


The Borough will continue to operate the curbside appliance collection program, but will move to collection once per month, on the first Wednesday. Appliances and larger metal items will require pre-scheduling for pickup, and the payment of a \$20 fee per item. Appliances and metals are common household appliances, like washers, dryers, lawn mowers and large exercise equipment. A fuller list of items that have a fee for collection is available on the Borough's website.

Some items —like appliances that contain Freon, construction materials, hazardous waste, TVs & computer monitors ("Covered Devices") and very large or unwieldy items, like pianos or pool tables—are not accepted in the Borough's trash or recycling program.

To make the transition as smooth as possible, the Borough will launch a public education plan, sharing articles and press releases, adding more informational materials to the Borough's website including a list of items accepted as bulky waste, appliances & metals, and a list of unacceptable items. Also planned is information for residents on alternative ways to donate, recycle, or otherwise dispose of bulky waste items. Additionally, Borough staff will be trained on the updated guidelines, and the website will offer an online form for residents to schedule and pay for appliance collection.

These changes to the bulky waste program are designed to reduce disposal costs, provide partial cost-recovery, and create a more sustainable waste management system for Perkasie Borough. The updates follow other efficiency measures, such as the installation of a baling machine at the Borough's Recycling Center which, since its installation in 2022, has helped to significantly reduce storage and hauling costs for recycling paper and cardboard.






A MESSAGE FROM THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT

PROTECTING OUR WATERWAYS: UNDERSTANDING MS4 IN PENNSYLVANIA

Stormwater management is an essential part of maintaining clean and healthy communities. In Pennsylvania, Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems (MS4) play a key role in controlling stormwater runoff and preventing pollution in our local waterways. But what exactly is MS4, and why does it matter?

What is MS4? MS4 refers to a system of storm drains, pipes, and ditches designed to collect and channel rainwater and snowmelt away from roads and properties. Unlike combined sewer systems, which handle both wastewater and stormwater, MS4 systems keep them separate—reducing the risk of overflows and contamination.

Why MS4 Matters for Our Community Stormwater runoff can carry pollutants such as oil, chemicals, and debris into nearby rivers, lakes, and streams. Left unmanaged, these contaminants can harm wildlife, degrade water quality, and pose risks to public health. To combat these issues, Pennsylvania's Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) requires municipalities to implement MS4 programs that focus on six key areas:

- Public Education Raising awareness about stormwater pollution and prevention.
- Public Involvement Encouraging community participation in water protection efforts.
- Illicit Discharge Detection Identifying and eliminating unauthorized pollution sources.
- · Construction Site Runoff Control Preventing sediment and pollutants from entering storm drains.
- Post-Construction Stormwater Management Ensuring long-term pollution control measures.
- Municipal Pollution Prevention Reducing environmental impact from municipal operations.

How Can You Help? MS4 regulations not only protect our environment but also involve the community in safeguarding our water resources. Residents and businesses can contribute by properly disposing of waste, minimizing the use of harmful chemicals, and reporting potential stormwater pollution. Additionally, municipalities are required to monitor and improve their stormwater management practices, ensuring compliance with state and federal guidelines.

By working together to uphold MS4 standards, we can protect our waterways, preserve natural resources, and create a healthier, more sustainable environment for generations to come.

RECYCLING CENTER

The Borough Recycling Center, located behind the Perkasie Police Department, at 311 South 9th Street, is for the convenience of Borough Residents ONLY.

Hours are Monday through Friday 7:30am-8:30pm and Saturdays 7:30am-4:00pm. As a reminder it is CLOSED Sundays and most holidays. Perkasie Borough staff may ask for identification when you use the Center.

There are signs indicating where recyclable materials are to be placed. No plastic bags, please. Combine glass, aluminum, tin and plastic (PDE #1-7) containers in the dumpsters that are marked as such and that have metal stairs. Combine newspaper and cardboard and place in the recycling shed at the rear of the center. Trash and bulky items are not accepted at the Recycling Center.

MESSAGE FROM THE PERKASIE ELECTRIC DEPARTMENT

In coming months, we will continue replacing our electric meter on your property as part of our Borough Council approved plan to upgrade all our customers' electric meters. Your new meter will benefit you in several ways: It will help us improve the reliability of your service by better detecting power outages. And, over time, the new meters will give you improved access to data that will help you manage your energy use.

Here's what you can expect during the replacement:

- Borough employees will perform the meter replacement work during the work week between 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. The employees will be in Borough marked vehicles, wearing Borough clothing, with Borough identification. All residents have the option to call the Borough if they are unsure if it's a Borough employee at their door or a scammer.
- The technician performing the installation will knock on your door before they begin working. The installation will take about 10 minutes to complete, during which time you may briefly lose power.
- You do not need to be home for the installation as long as the meter is outdoors and our technicians have clear and safe access.
- If our electric meter is located indoors, or in another location that is inaccessible, you will need to be present to provide access. Installations will take place from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. If your meter is not accessible and you will not be available during these hours over the next few months, please contact 215-257-5065 to schedule an appointment.

We are committed to keeping all of our customers informed before their meters are replaced, this project will be completed in 3 years, and new letters will go out each year to the residents that have not had their meter replaced yet.





ZONING AND CODE DEPARTMENT

Spring Projects and Understanding Perkasie Borough's Permit Process

Spring is a busy time for home improvement and outdoor projects, making it essential to understand the permitting process to keep your plans on track. Perkasie Borough's Zoning and Building Code Department ensures all work complies with safety, zoning, and environmental standards. Use this guide to determine when permits are needed and how to make the process seamless.

When are permits needed permits?

- A **Zoning Permit** is required for several activities, including creating new impervious surface such sheds, decks and pools, establishing a new use, changing, expanding, or converting an existing use, non-residential ownership changes.
- A **Building Permit** is required for new construction, additions, or alterations for both residential and non-residential properties. This also includes projects involving plumbing, electrical, or mechanical system work. Residential building permits application have a 15-business day review period, while commercial project has 30 business days.
- A Grading Permit is required for any project involving more than 400 square feet of earth disturbance. A Stormwater Permit is necessary for the installation of any new impervious surface exceeding 1,000 square feet or for cumulative impervious surface areas over 1000 square feet that has been installed since February 21, 2005. Grading and Stormwater applications are reviewed by the Borough Engineer and requires a professional service agreement.

What doesn't need a permit?

- Building permits are not required for exterior replacements like windows, doors, and siding, provided they are "in kind" replacements. Any structural changes to the building will trigger building permit requirements.
- Fences do not require a permit unless the fence is above 7 feet. However, residents should verify that fences are not placed in any easements, right-a-ways, restricted deed areas.

Follow these tips to save time and avoid setbacks:

- **Start Early:** Not sure if your project requires a permit? Reach out to the Borough early in the planning stages to prevent delays or potential violations.
- Have Your Documents Ready: Double-check that your submission includes all necessary drawings, plans, and supporting documents to ensure your application is complete. All applications and plan requirements can be found on the Borough website.
- **Secure Approvals from Other Agencies:** Certain projects may need approval from additional agencies, such as Perkasie Regional Authorities, the Department of Environmental Protection, or the Bucks County Conservation District. Make sure to confirm these requirements before submitting.
- **Review Local Regulations:** Familiarize yourself with Perkasie Borough's Code and current Building Code to ensure compliance with zoning, building, and stormwater management rules.







• **Consult Professionals:** For complex projects like grading or stormwater management, work with licensed professionals to ensure compliance and streamline the review process.

Tips for Avoiding Nuisance Grass and Weed Violations

Maintaining your property in compliance with Perkasie Borough codes ensures a clean, safe, and welcoming community for all. Overgrown grass, weeds, bushes, and trees not only diminish neighborhood aesthetics but can also create safety and health risks. Here's what you need to know to avoid nuisance violations and keep Perkasie beautiful.

Why Does It Matter?

Overgrown vegetation contributes to blight and can harbor pests such as rodents, snakes, and insects. It may also create fire hazards, reduce visibility for drivers, and obstruct public pathways. Proper maintenance of your property helps ensure safety and a higher quality of life for everyone in the borough.

Rules for Compliance

Perkasie Borough code requires that property owners and tenants adhere to these key rules for vegetation maintenance:

- Maintain Clearance: Trim or remove vegetation overhanging streets, alleys, or sidewalks to allow at least 8 feet of clearance above sidewalks and 14 feet above streets.
- **Keep Grass Short:** Lawn grasses, including areas in front, back, sides, and public right-of-way zones, must remain under 12 inches tall.
- Avoid Obstruction: Trim trees and bushes that may obscure traffic signs, intersections, or fire hydrants. Maintain a 3-foot clearance around fire hydrants to assist emergency services.
- Fire Safety: Remove dry, overgrown vegetation that could pose a fire hazard.
- No Grass Clippings in Streets: Avoid blowing fresh-cut grass into streets, as it creates a slippery hazard for pedestrians, cyclists, and motorcyclists.

What Happens if You Don't Comply?

Non-compliance with borough codes can result in warnings, penalties, or additional measures. Property owners will receive a mailed notice outlining the issue and are given 7 days to address the violation. Failure to comply within this timeframe could lead to fines or assessments by the borough.

How to Learn More

For detailed information, review Perkasie Borough's regulations in the Chapter 65: Brush, Grass, Plants and Weeds. This section provides definitions, responsibilities, and penalties for violations.

Have a Concern or Need Help?

To report a potential code violation, at 215-257-5065 and ask to file a report with the Code Enforcement Officer. Please note that disputes between private property owners regarding overgrowth must be resolved independently.

The Police Department grant-funded Crime Victims Advocate Program has been busy with a multitude of projects including most recently a program to assist the homeless which was implemented after encounters with individuals experiencing homelessness in our community. Concerned Perkasie Police officers came to the Community Relations Specialist, Chris Doheny, with the idea of obtaining grab bags with non-perishable foods and essential supplies that can be utilized for individuals in need. Chris quickly took over the project and started a new partnership with Revivals Outreach Center in Perkasie.

Through this partnership, the department was able to immediately gain access to 18 grab bags full of snack foods, hygiene items, hats and gloves, and other useful items for those experiencing homelessness. Local homeless shelter and housing organization resource lists were added to each bag to allow for quick and easy access to both immediate and long-term resources and assistance.

The Perkasie Police Department will continue to partner with Revivals to establish a food and essential items donation drive to work towards the goal of supplying grab bags not just for Perkasie Police, but also all of the other Upper Bucks police departments.

As front-line workers, Perkasie Police are in a unique position to not only identify those who are struggling in our community but also provide them access to short-term relief and housing resources. Partnered with the Bucks County Co-Responder and Victim Service programs, the police department continues to seek comprehensive social service delivery for the betterment of all members of our community, regardless of their housing status.

This month, the Community Relations Specialist also participated in a "Train the Trainer" event for Question, Persuade, Refer (QPR). This evidence-based training is designed to provide essential skills to ordinary citizens to identify persons experiencing suicidal thoughts, persuade them to get help, and refer them to the appropriate professional intervention service. As a certified trainer, the Community

Relations Specialist will be partnering with local businesses, churches, schools, and other community organizations to provide QPR training free of charge. These trainings will help lead to a community that not only recognizes those who need assistance but also lead them to the assistance that they need.

As rates of suicide continue to rise across the country, the Perkasie Police Department considers these types of interventions a critical piece of ensuring a healthy and safe community. We hope that QPR, alongside our Crisis trained officers and other crisis intervention services, can help save lives and limit further tragedies."

Spring Safety Tips

Spring is in the air, and with the warmer weather comes spring cleaning and home maintenance! The Perkasie Fire Company wants to remind everyone to keep safety top of mind as you tackle your spring chores. Here are a few

helpful tips:

- Gasoline Storage: Always store gasoline in approved, tightly sealed containers. Never bring gasoline containers inside your home.
- **Proper Disposal of Rags:** Rags used with stain or paint can be a fire hazard. After use, take them outside to dry in a well-ventilated area, away from direct sunlight and structures. Never pile used rags together, as this can lead to spontaneous combustion.
- **Grill Safety:** Before firing up the grill for the first time this season, thoroughly inspect and clean it. Remove any spider webs, debris, and grease buildup. Ensure your propane tank is properly connected and check the hose line for leaks before use.
- **Home Maintenance:** As you dust and clean inside your home, remember to check your vents, smoke detectors (remove dust and spider webs), and replace filters.
- **Fire Safety Checks:** Take some time to inspect your household fire extinguishers and test the batteries in your smoke and carbon monoxide detectors.







Stormwater

Preventing Stormwater Pollution

Warmer weather is on the horizon! Increasing temperatures mean longer days, budding leaves, blooming flowers and spring rain. While rain showers are important for the environment, they also have the ability to lead to harmful stormwater pollution. Below are some tips for preventing pollution this spring:

- Only rain belongs in the drain! As you're cleaning up your yard this spring, remember that storm drains are not garbage disposals. Never dump anything, including leaves and grass clippings, into a storm drain.
- Use lawn chemicals sparingly. Always follow the application instructions and never use before it rains. Switch to organic fertilizers where possible or mulch leaves and grass clippings into your yard to add nutrients back into your soil.
- Replace turf grass with natives! Lawns have little to no environmental benefits and turf grass requires lots of maintenance to stay green. Swap your lawn for native perennials by adding more garden space in your yard! Not only do natives require less maintenance than turf grass, they are vital for the health of our environment and the survival of pollinators, birds and other wildlife.

Helping Wildlife this Spring

Spring means increased activity for wildlife, with many species busy gathering food, building nests and caring for their young. You can take small steps at home to provide important food sources and habitat for our local wildlife during the spring months:

- Plant for pollinators. Plant with a variety of native species that flower throughout the year to provide pollinators with vital food sources.
- Recreate outdoors responsibly. Spring is a great time to explore the great outdoors! Be respectful of wildlife during your visit by sticking to paths, keeping dogs on leash and taking litter home.
- Provide food and water for wildlife. Early in the season, food may be scarce and water sources can still be frozen. Make sure replenish and clean feeders and bird baths regularly.
- Plant trees and shrubs. Trees and shrubs have immense benefits for wildlife! Leaves, flowers, bark and branches provide vital resources for a wide variety of species.




