

PERKASIE BOROUGH PARKS & RECREATION BOARD

January 21, 2026, 6:30 p.m.

Perkasie Borough Hall

The monthly meeting of the Perkasie Parks and Recreation Board was called to order at 6:32 pm on January 21, 2026, by Lauren Moll. Members present were Joe Koenig, Joan Loeb, Joel Nieto, Lynne Kallus Rainey, Kathy Rocchetti and Jamon Yerger. Absent was Robyn Rapp. Staff Present: Lauren Moll, Parks and Recreation Director, Lauren Bahry, Events Assistant, Shiv Gandevia, Perkasie Borough Council Youth Representative, Lilli Benner, Perkasie Borough Council Representative, Dave Worthington, Perkasie Borough Council Representative, and Jeff Hollenbach, Perkasie Borough Mayor.

1. Public Forum – None.
2. Reorganization of Chair, Vice Chair, Secretary for 2025
 - Kathy was nominated for Chair by Lynne; seconded by Joan. With no other nominations, Lynne made a motion to elect Kathy as Chair, seconded by Joan. All in favor.
 - Joel was nominated for Vice Chair by Kathy, seconded by Lynne. With no other nominations, Kathy made a motion to elect Joel as Vice Chair, seconded by Lynne. All in favor.
 - Robyn was nominated for Secretary by Lynne, seconded by Kathy. With no other nominations, Lynne made a motion to elect Robyn as Secretary, seconded by Kathy. All in favor.
3. Approval of Meeting Minutes – Upon a motion by Lynne, seconded by Jamon, the Board approved the minutes from the December 2025 meeting.
4. Kulp Scoreboard Presentation
 - Mayor Hollenbach thanked the Board for their active involvement in the Board and then presented the idea of a new scoreboard for Kulp ball field stating that the Borough is installing a new field but will need to use the old, outdated scoreboard when teams use the field. He explains that a new scoreboard will help draw more teams to the field and in turn boost visitors into the Borough.
 - The Board questioned the Mayor and staff regarding size, look, favorite choice, and the possibility of vandals.
 - Jamon asked about funding and Lauren explained that the Borough does not have funding nor grant funds approved for this project. The Mayor informed the Board that he is interested in looking for sponsorships toward the scoreboard. Jamon explained that he feels there are mixed feelings in the Borough regarding the project as a whole and that any new scoreboard should come with education of the value.
5. Old Business
 - Kulp Renovation Project
 - Lauren explained that there is no update on construction at this time due to winter weather. The Borough met with DCNR regarding required closeout documentation and completed rock drill change order which needs to be presented to Council for signature.
 - Community Garden

- Announcements were made on DCNR grant applications and the Borough was awarded the \$81,200 land acquisition grant toward the purchase of the community garden parcel.
- Budget 2026
 - Lauren informed the Board that the 2026 budget was approved at the December 15, 2025 Perkasio Borough Council meeting which included the capital expenditures toward the final skate park ramp, park cameras, infield groomer, backwash valves, and continued Menlo pump replacements.
- 6. New Business
 - Summer Concert Series
 - Lauren B explained the summer concert series process. The Board discussed possible band options and tentative schedule.
 - On a motion from Joe, seconded by Jamon, the Board recommends GruvTyme from the Dance/Party category. All in favor.
 - On a motion from Jamon, seconded by Joel, the Board recommends Hightsight from the Rock category. All in favor.
 - On a motion from Joe, seconded by Lynee, the Board recommends Brake for Turtles from the cover band category. All in favor.
 - On a motion from Kathy, seconded by Joan, the Board recommends Highway Run from the tribute category. All in favor.
 - On a motion from Joe, seconded by Jamon, the Board recommends Jake's Rockin' Country Band from the Country/American category. All in favor.
 - On a motion from Kathy, seconded by Jamon, the Board recommends Harvest Moon, Big Chill, and Midlife Crisis as alternatives. All in favor.
 - Kulp Scoreboard Discussion
 - The Board discussed the earlier scoreboard presentation. Joe commented that option #5 was too much. Lynne commented that a new scoreboard will help bring visitors to the Borough.
 - On a motion by Joe, seconded by Joan, the Board recommends to Council to consider the purchase of design option #4 or similar scoreboard if another similar vendor is found for Kulp Park ballfield. All in favor.
 - Scout Project Idea – Troop 2549
 - Lauren informed the Board of an upcoming Scout project which will be presented to Council in February. Troop 2549 is interested in building benches for the dog park.
 - E-bikes and Trail Etiquette
 - The Board continued to discuss e-bikes specifically in terms of possible trail etiquette rules that could be implemented for safe trail use.
 - The Spine Logo
 - Joel showed the Board new possible designs. The Board discussed and Jamon and Joel will edit and scan to send out to the Board.
 - Community Garden Ribbon Cutting Planning Ideas
 - The Board continued discussions for a ribbon cutting event planned for the week of May 4-8, 2026. Shiv suggested contacting the local school's environmental groups.
 - Kulp Park Ribbon Cutting Planning Ideas

- The Board continued discussions continued discussions on an upcoming ribbon cutting event.
- Park and Recreation Board April Event
 - Lauren reminded the Board that each April the Board hosts a Park Clean Up event. This year the Borough was on the waitlist for the Pennsylvania Wood Mobile which is available in April to attend an event. The Board discussed the options of changing the Park Clean Up to a Earth Day Event. Lynne would like to see an Earth Day event with an emphasis on wildlife and Dave would like to continue the bulb drive with a possible drop-off location as well.

 - Dave informed the board of the upcoming PRPS meeting this Spring.
- 8. Adjourn: There being no additional business, the meeting adjourned at 8:37 pm with a motion by Kathy.
